RULES

1. The tematic of the papers should stick to the paper theme proposed by the organisers..

2. Writing standards: MS WORD, A4, Romanian, one sidedă paragraph single, margins 2,5, Times New Roman, 14 pt and 12 pt for footnotes.

Each paper will contain the followings:

- a. Summary;
- b. Abreviation list (if exists);
- c. Bibliography;
- d. The full paper.

3. The presentation of papers: The Organisational Comitee will determine the place of the conference and also the order of the presentations, by odds. Only the students authors of the papers can present them. Additional materials could be used, such as charts, retroprojectors or Power Point Presentation.

In case of the use of the last two additional materials, the Organisational Comitee could be announced once with the sending of the sign up form. Each participant will turn over a copy of the paper at the conference, for the jury.

The time for each presentation is 10 minutes. The extention of the time, over 10 minutes, could be allowed if the jury wants to. The members of the jury can address questions to the authors during the oral presentation and also after it.

4. Evaluation: The papers and the oral presentation will be evaluated by the jury. The consistence of the jury will be determined by rules.

The best papers will be awarded. The jury reserves also the right to give special awards.

Participating terms

A participant can submite and present only **one** paper – (max. 10 pages).

There are not accepted papers with co-author.
